Minutes of the 51st Annual Convention
Amarillo, Texas
“Walk in Love as Christ Loved Us” (Ephesians 5:2)

Friday, September 11, 2009

The Opening Eucharist of the 51st Annual Convention and Ordination to the Diaconate of Todd Lee Baxley began at 7:00 P.M. at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, Amarillo, Texas. The Rt. Rev. Scott Mayer preached the sermon (Attachment D: Opening Holy Eucharist and Ordination) and ordained Todd to the diaconate. The offering in the amount of \$ 1,292 was designated half for the new deacon's discretionary fund and half for Millennium Development Goals. A reception followed in the parish hall.

Saturday, September 12, 2009

The 51st Annual Convention of the Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Northwest Texas, meeting at the Amarillo Civic Center, was convened at 8:30 A.M. The Rev. Clifton Mann, Host Rector, led the Convention in morning worship. The Rt. Rev. Scott Mayer led the Commissioning of Lay Delegates.

Bishop Mayer introduced convention officers, members of the dais, and diocesan staff: Mr. Tom Choate, Chancellor; Mr. Carrol Holley; Diocesan Treasurer; the Rev. Pat Russell, Chair of Dispatch of Business; The Hon. Don Emerson, Parliamentarian; Ms Liza Philpy, Secretary of the Diocese and Chair of the Credentials Committee; and Ms Carolyn Hearn, Executive Secretary and Chair of the Necrology Committee. Bishop Mayer also introduced Mrs. Anna Mora, Finance Manager; Mrs. Renee Haney, new Diocesan Youth Coordinator; Mrs. Nancy Igo, Ministry Coordinator; Ms Jamie Goldston, Director of the Bishop Quarterman Conference Center; and the Ven. Chris Wrampelmeier, Archdeacon. Bishop Mayer then called on the Rev. Clifton Mann who introduced members of St. Andrew's Arrangements Committee: Mrs. M. J. Coats, Mrs. H. Q. Wrampelmeier, Ms Marty Newkirk, and others.

Bishop Mayer welcomed guests and visitors to the Convention: Mr. Ben Chandler, Vice-President for Institutional Advancement at the Seminary of the Southwest in Austin, and the Rev. Pat Russell, Trustee from the University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee, who gave a report from Sewanee.

Bishop Mayer introduced new clergy in the diocese since the 2009 Convention:

The Rev. Todd Baxley, ordained to the diaconate Friday evening at St. Andrew's, Amarillo.

The Rev. Barbara Kirk-Norris, transferred from the Diocese of Kentucky, Rector of St. Mary the Virgin, Big Spring.

Deacon Leroy Morrison, transferred from Central New York, Deacon at St. Barnabas', Amarillo.

The Rev. Jean Pearson Scott, ordained to the Priesthood at St. Stephen's, Lubbock.

The Rev. Patricia Griffith Russell, ordained to the Priesthood at St. Paul's, Lubbock

The Rev. Charles Layne Smith, transferred from Alaska, new Rector at St. John's, Odessa.

The Rev. Kiah Webster, transferred from Southern Ohio, Assistant Rector at St. Paul's, Lubbock

The Rev. Phillip Webster, also from Southern Ohio, Canterbury Chaplain in Lubbock and Priest-in-Charge at St. Luke's, Levelland.

The Rev. Kara Wischmeyer, transferred from Dallas, serving as Pastoral Minister and Supply Priest at St. Stephen's, Lubbock.

The Rev. Philip Ray, not new to the diocese but the new Rector at St. James', Dalhart.

The Rev. Melinda Harlow, an ELCA pastor who has been licensed to supply in the diocese, who resides in Amarillo.

Deacon Don Webb of Eastland, now serving as Deacon at Trinity, Albany.

Deacon Fran Bessie, now serving as Deacon at St. Paul's, Lubbock.

Bishop Mayer introduced Scott Lee of St. Andrew's, Amarillo, a junior seminarian at Seminary of the Southwest in Austin, and his wife Ashley. The bishop asked ECW officers to stand.

Bishop Mayer introduced the Rev. Kelly Conkling of San Angelo who led the Convention in the use of art as a spiritual practice.

Bishop Mayer called on Ms Liza Philpy, Secretary of Convention and Chair of the Credentials Committee, who reported that a quorum was present with 186 registered voters (Attachment A: Report of the Credentials Committee).

Bishop Mayer then called the 51st Annual Diocesan Convention to order. Mr. Andy Garcia moved that voice be given to guests of the Convention. The motion was seconded and passed.

Mrs. Pat Russell, on behalf of the Dispatch of Business Committee, moved adoption of the Order of Business as amended. The motion was seconded and passed. Mrs. Jackie Batjer of Heavenly Rest, Abilene, Chair of the Approval of 2008 Convention Minutes Committee, moved that the minutes of the 50th Diocesan Convention be accepted as printed. The motion passed.

Bishop Mayer introduced Deacon Les Jackson of St. Christopher's, Lubbock, who led the Convention in the use of icons as spiritual practice.

Bishop Mayer asked that the convention confirm his appointments to the 2010 Commission on Ministry, Chancellor of the Diocese, and Registrar of the Diocese (Attachment C: Bishop's Appointments). The Rev. Pat Russell moved the Bishop's Appointments be confirmed and the motion passed.

Bishop Mayer called on the Rev. Linda Kelly, Chair of the Nominations Committee, who moved the following nominations on behalf of the committee:

Bishop Mayer asked for any nominations from the floor and noted that nominations from the floor must be presented in writing with the nomination properly completed on forms available from Carolyn Hearn. The Rev. Jim Liggett, St. Nicholas', Midland, was nominated for the Standing Committee Clergy term to 2012. There being no further nominations, Bishop Mayer declared the nominations closed.

In accordance with the Constitution, Bishop Mayer instructed Diocesan Secretary Liza Philpy, to cast a ballot on behalf of the Convention for all unopposed positions: Standing Committee Lay to 2012, Mr. Michael P. Ryan; Trustee to 2014, Mr. David Stidham; and Ecclesiastical Trial Court Clergy to 2012 and 2013, the Rev. Clifton Mann and Archdeacon Chris Wrampelmeier.

Bishop Mayer called upon Mrs. Georgia Swift, Chair of the Elections Committee, who explained the voting procedures. The first ballots were distributed, collected, and Bishop Mayer declared the polls closed.

Following a fifteen minute break, Bishop Mayer presented his address to the 51st Diocesan Convention. (Attachment E: Convention Address).

Bishop Mayer and Mr. Dick Davis of St. Andrew's, Amarillo, reported on the 2009 General Convention which took place in Anaheim, California in July.

The convention was led in the spiritual practice of Taizé prayer and singing at Noonday. Convention reconvened following lunch at 1:30 P.M.

Bishop Mayer read the results of the first ballots:

The second ballots were distributed and, following voting, Bishop Mayer declared the polls closed. Bishop Mayer introduced Mr. David Morrow of Santa Maria Virgen in Midland who presented a report on mission and ministry in the Dominican Republic.

Bishop Mayer read the results of the second ballot:

Mrs. Betty Gilmore moved that third ballots elect position by plurality vote. The motion was seconded and passed.

Third ballots were distributed and, following voting, Bishop Mayer declared the polls closed

Mr. Jim Brown presented the Treasurer's Report on behalf of Treasurer Carrol Holley, the Budget Committee, and the Executive Council. The 2008 Audit Report and 2009 Budget and Actual Report and the 2010 Budget were presented. Brief discussion followed.

The Credentials Committee report was amended to reflect a total of 199 voters registered at this point in the convention. Bishop Mayer read the results of the third ballot:

The Rev. Patricia G. Russell - 44

The Rev. Jim Liggett - 50

Following a fifteen minute break, Bishop Mayer introduced Mrs. Nancy Igo who led the Convention in Sign Chi Do as spiritual practice.

Archdeacon Chris Wrampelmeier reported on the work of the Bishop Quarterman Conference Center Visioning Team followed by a report by Bishop Quarterman Conference Center Director, Mrs. Jamie Goldston.

Deacon Todd Baxley and Mrs. Carole Wolf reported on the 2009 Happy Camp. Mrs. Katy Hoskins, Director of the 2009 Promise Camp, presented Deacon Roland Rose with a gift of a book of photos of the past five years of Promise Camp. Deacon Rose received a standing ovation. Mrs. Hoskins reported on the 2009 Promise Camp.

The Rev. Jim Haney, V, on a point of personal privilege, stated that he had spent 17 summers of his life at the Bishop Quarterman Conference Center and noted that the Diocese of Kansas does not have a conference center. He stated he stays in touch with seventy of his fellow campers, six of whom are now clergy. He also noted that the counselors are some of the best he has ever seen.

Mrs. Nancy Igo updated the Convention on the status of Safeguarding God's Children in the Diocese.

On behalf of the Resolutions Committee, the Rev. Mary Glover presented the following resolutions:

Whereas David Morrow, with the Dominican Development Group, has come home, even at the risk of experiencing a bit of too-cool weather, to inform and educate us about the conditions, opportunities, needs and joys of the beloved people and our beloved Church in the Dominican Republic; and

Whereas the mission work in the Dominican Republic is laudable and life-giving; and

Whereas we are connected to such work by our common call to mission and through the visible servant-leadership of David, the people of Santa Maria Virgen and St. Nicholas, and our friends, Michael and April Floyd; be it hereby

Resolved that this 51st Annual Convention of the Episcopal Diocese of Northwest Texas offer its thanks to David Morrow for his presentation and, further, that the people of Northwest Texas consider ways, small and large, to offer very liberal support and encouragement for the continuance and growth of this ministry in the Dominican Republic.

Both resolutions were adopted as presented.

Following announcements Bishop Mayer introduced Deacon Art Goolsbee who led the convention in evening worship and the spiritual practice of Centering Prayer.

A dinner and dance at the Amarillo Club on the 31st floor of the Chase Bank Building ended the Saturday of the 51st Annual Diocesan Convention with views of Amarillo and the surrounding area and a typically beautiful Panhandle sunset.

Sunday, September 13, 2009

Ms Liza Philpy confirmed that a quorum was present and Bishop Mayer called the second session of the 51st Annual Diocesan Convention to order in the nave of St. Andrew's Church.

Following opening prayers, Bishop Mayer introduced the Rev. Phillip Webster, Chaplain of Canterbury Campus Ministry in Lubbock, who reported on his ministry there.

Bishop Mayer introduced the Rev. David Mossbarger who reported on Health Ministries and Parish Nursing in the diocese and announced a parish nursing seminar will be held in the Permian Basin on February 4-7, 2010. Bishop Mayer then introduced Mrs. Gwen Burns who reported on the ministry of the Church Periodical Club.

Mr. Greg Westmoreland moved to accept printed reports in the convention report packet and distributed at convention by title. The motion was seconded and passed.

Mr. Jim Brown, for Treasurer Carrol Holley, moved adoption of the proposed 2010 budget as printed. The motion passed. Mr. Brown also moved adoption of the 2010 apportionments as printed. The motion passed.

The Rev. Mary Glover and Mr. Michael Pullen presented the following resolutions on behalf of the Resolutions Committee:

HEARTS, EYES, BODIES, EARS

WHEREAS the Rev. Kelly Conkling has drawn our hearts into prayer, has assured us that even our most primitive "stick figures" can walk us toward God, and, though she may not know the number, has pointed us toward God's address on Mandala Circle; and

WHEREAS Deacon Les Jackson has directed our eyes toward the windows that reveal creation's splendor, and has shared, through music and images (and in less than 2 hours), the icons' litany of colors and visionary prayer; and

WHEREAS, despite the rooster's crow, Nancy Igo has engaged our whole bodies - all hemispheres, all feet, hands and arms - in reaching out for God through movement and posture and reaching inward to know God's breath and presence; and

WHEREAS Deacon Art Goolsbee has alerted our ears - not to listen for who can whisper the loudest, but - to hear and translate God's first language of silence as a message of perpetual grace; be it hereby

WHEREAS the gathering of saints at St. Andrew's has opened its doors, arms and hearts to all of us; and

WHEREAS Clifton Mann, Jo Mann, and Chris Wrampelmeier have invited us into the holy space of their parish's worship and praise; and

WHEREAS Todd Baxley has shared with us the occasion of his ordination and made us witnesses, once again, to God's powers of joy, creation, acceptance, blessing, and Good News; and

WHEREAS our hosts have led us from the depths of Lowndes Hall to the heights of the Chase Bank building, and Margaret Lacy and the musicians have led us from the depths of the organ pipes and cello tones to the heights of the violin and joyous sounds of singing; and

WHEREAS all the volunteers, cooks, altar guild, sextons, ushers, nursery workers, and clean-up crews have made a daunting undertaking look easy; therefore be it

RESOLVED that the good people of this Diocese, gathered as the 51st Annual Convention in Northwest Texas, express to you - as they see fit - that we are so very grateful you are here - emerging - as our Bishop!

The resolutions passed unanimously.

Bishop Mayer introduced the Rev. James Haney, V (AKA "Cinco"), Rector of St. Paul's-on-the-Plains, Lubbock, and Mrs. JoAnn Griffin, Chair of the Convention Arrangements Committee, who invited the 52nd Annual Diocesan Convention to Lubbock on October 8 and 9, 2010 and noted that 2010 is the centennial year of St. Paul's Church.

Following announcements and the Commissioning of Elected and Appointed Diocesan Officials and Staff, Bishop Mayer declared convention adjourned sine die following the Convention Eucharist.

The Convention Eucharist was held at St. Andrew's Church with Bishop Mayer preaching (Attachment F) and the Rev. Clifton Mann celebrating. The Necrology List since the 2008 Diocesan Convention was read at the Eucharist (Attachment B). The offering at the Eucharist in the amount of \$1,442.75 was designated for Mission and Ministry in the Dominican Republic.
